REFLECTION SHEET

Part of our behavioural policy at NPACS is to have a reflection sheet for behaviours that are unacceptable and require further action. If a child receives a reflection sheet, they will fill it in at school, bring it home to be discussed and signed with the parents, and returned back to school. It is important that we work together to ensure that our children learn about restorative justice and the importance of learning from choices made.
